Dream Big. Fly High!

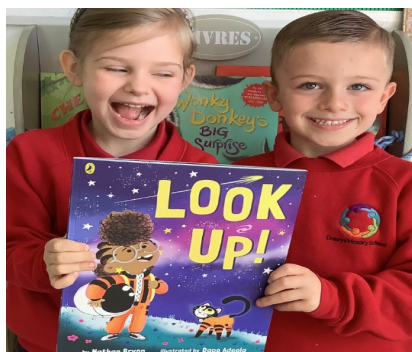
