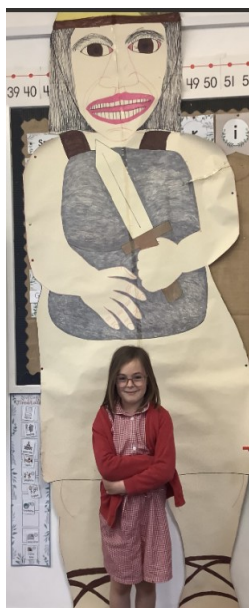


# Doxey Digest
