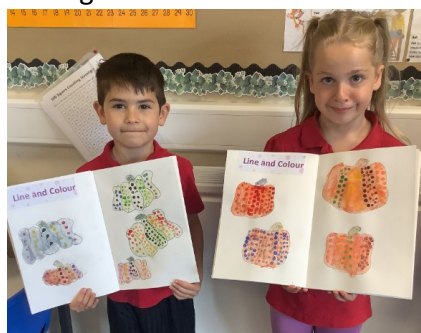
We welcomed Sam Compton, the Trust's CEO, to school this week. Teaching and Learning shone as a huge strength as we walked around the school.
