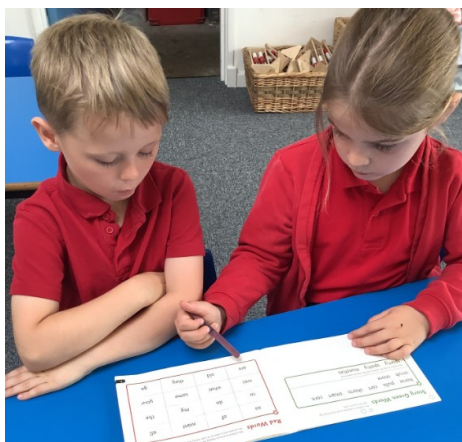


Doxey Digest
